

Frank Porreca, PhD

Dr. Porreca is a professor in the Department of Pharmacology at the University of Arizona in Tucson. Author of more than 300 original, peer-reviewed articles addressing mechanisms of chronic pain and its treatment, Dr. Porreca has been recognized as a “Highly Cited” investigator by Pub Med and declared one of the 10 most cited pharmacologists in the world by the American Society of Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics. For his discoveries on the adaptive nature of the brain following nerve injury, Dr. Porreca was honored by the American Pain Society with the Frederick W. Kerr Award for Basic Research in Pain, by Harvard University and Brigham and Women’s Hospital as the Covino Visiting Pain Professor, and by Albany Medical College as the Sterling Professor of Pharmacology. He serves as co-Editor-in-Chief of *Life Sciences*, section editor for *Pain*, and sits on the editorial boards of numerous other journals in the field.
