B. Lee Peterlin, DO, is the director of the Drexel University College of Medicine Headache Clinic. She is an Assistant Professor of Neurology as well as an Assistant Professor of Pharmacology and Physiology at Drexel University College of Medicine in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Dr. Peterlin received her medical degree from the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine. She completed her neurology residency and neurophysiology fellowship at the Penn State Hershey Medical Center. She then completed a headache fellowship at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center. Dr Peterlin's research has focused on the characterization and pathophysiological basis of the role of obesity and the role of stress-related disorders, such as post-traumatic stress disorder and physical and sexual abuse, in episodic and chronic migraine. She has published several articles on headache, as well as co-edited a handbook for primary care physicians on menstrually-related migraine with Dr. Susan Hutchinson.
