Marie Denuelle, MD is a hospital practitioner in the Neurology Department at the University Hospital Center of Toulouse, France. She earned her Master of Medical and Biological Sciences degree from the Faculty of Medicine of Lyon in 1999 and did her residency in the Faculty of Medicine in Toulouse between 1999 and 2004, where she also completed her Medical Thesis in 2004. Her postgraduate specializations include diplomas in epileptology and neuropsychology (2003), as well as a specialized post-graduate degree in neurology (2004). Her clinical research has focused on using positron emission tomography to study spontaneous migraine attacks and photophobia in migraineurs. In 2009, the National Headache Foundation presented Dr. Denuelle with the Seymour Diamond, MD, Lectureship Award for the quality and importance of her work in this area.
