Nancy E. J. Berman, PhD, is professor of Anatomy and Cell Biology and research director of Neurosurgery at the University of Kansas Medical Center, Kansas City, KS. Her earlier research concerned mechanisms of neuroplasticity in the visual system. More recently, she has focused on the role of inflammatory responses in outcomes after traumatic brain injury and in the basic science of migraine. She serves on the national board of the Organization for the Study of Sex Differences and has served as a member and chair of scientific review panels for the National Institutes of Health, Department of Defense, and the Veteran's Administration. She received the Harold G. Wolff award from the American Headache Society in 2006 and the AHS/Merck US Human Health Migraine and Women's Health Research Award from the American Headache Society in 2008.
