Dr. Baloh is professor of Neurology and Surgery (Head and Neck) at the UCLA School of Medicine. He has worked on the basic and clinical aspects of the vestibular system since the early 1970s. He has published more than 300 articles in peer-reviewed journals and authored several textbooks. The overall focus of his work has been the clinical neurophysiology of the vestibular system. Recent research has focused on dizziness and balance disorders in older people and the genetic causes of vertigo and ataxia. He continues to teach residents and fellows and sees patients with dizziness and balance disorders on a regular basis.
